Policy and Procedure Regarding Treatment of ADD/ADHD

The following is Brentwood Pediatrics procedure for ADHD evaluations the standard of care for the treatment of ADD/ADHD diagnoses.

Initial Evaluations

- Before meeting with the doctor for a one hour evaluation, Vanderbilt forms will need to be filled out by a parent and a teacher. Forms can be found on our website or we can email or mail you copies.
- When forms are returned along with current report cards (if available), the set will go to the PCP for review and scoring. **Once the PCP has completed their review of the forms, they will alert staff to schedule the evaluation.**
- **Evaluation times vary depending on your child's primary physician.**

The following is the **standard of care** for all patients with an ADD/ADHD diagnosis:

- Yearly physical examination
- Medication check visit every 3 - 6 months
- **Follow-up Vanderbilt questionnaires** (1 parent/1 teacher) will be before every 6 month medication check appointment. **These should be completed and submitted to physician before appointment.**
- **Thirty (30) day medication check after beginning initial medication. (No Vanderbilt required)**
- Physicians may be unable to authorize medication refills for noncompliance of above visit protocol.
- **Request refills 2-3 days in advance**
