

Your Individual Rights

- Review and obtain copies of medical information. There is a charge for copying and postage.
- Receive a list of all the times we or our business associated or shared medical information for purposes other than treatment, payment and healthcare operations and other specified expectations.
- Request restrictions on our use and disclosure of medical information. We are not required to agree with restrictions.
- Request that we communicate about medical information by different means or at different locations.
- Request that we change medical information. We may deny those requests.
- Receive a detailed copy outlining our privacy notice from our staff.

If you have any questions about this notice, please ask the receptionist for help or ask to speak to our Privacy Officer.

If you think we may have violated any privacy rights, contact our Privacy Officer at 314-918-8827. We will also provide you with the address to file your complaint with the US Department of Health and Human Services. We will not retaliate in any way if you choose to file a complaint.

OUR LEGAL DUTY

Law Requires us to:

1. Keep information private.
2. Give notice describing our legal duties, privacy practices and patients' rights regarding medical information.
3. Follow the terms of the notice that is now in effect.

We Have the Right to:

1. Change our privacy practices and the terms at any time, provided the changes are permitted by law.
2. Make changes in our privacy practices and the new terms of our notice effective for all medical information that we keep, including information previously created or received before the changes.

Notice of Change:

1. Before we make an important change in our privacy practices, we will change this notice and make the new notice available upon request.

Use and Disclosure of Medical Information

This is how we use and disclose medical information. Note: We will not use or disclose medical information for any purpose not listed below without appropriate specific written authorization. Any specific written authorization you provide may be revoked at any time by writing to us.

For Treatment: We may disclose medical information to doctors, nurses, technicians, med students, or others in the care of our patients.

For Payment: We may disclose medical information for payment purposes.

For Health Care Operations: We may use and disclose medical information for our health care operations. This may include measuring and improving quality, evaluating the performance of employees, obtaining creditation, licenses we need to serve our patients.
